

MEMPHIS MUSIC BOOSTERS MEETING MINUTES

SEPT 22, 2009

1. Meeting called to order at 7 pm
2. Members present: Tammy Pink, Rae Goulette, Karen Zuniga, Michelle Lentz, Kelly Smalley, Rayme Niezgoda, Sandy Sturm, Teri Horton, Teresa Thomas, Joshua Eash, Dawn Almstadt
3. Agenda reviewed, Tammy Pink motioned to accept, Rae Goulette seconded. Meeting minutes reviewed, Tammy motioned to accept and Sandy seconded. Treasurers report submitted and reviewed, Rae motioned to accept, Karen seconded.
4. The CD is up for renewal for another year by Oct 1, if we do not pull it out, it will automatically be renewed for another year. Anticipate making approx \$72 if leave it. Motion to put it in the savings account instead by Michelle, seconded by Tammy, passed.
5. Director report: Mr Eash suggested considering washable uniforms instead of the heavy duty ones we are using. We may be able to get 10+ yrs usage out of them if we dry clean them. Planning on ordering about 100 uniforms for approx \$250 each (25,000) as opposed to \$40,000 for the other ones. Possibility of selling our old uniforms also to another school. 2 field trips coming up, voluntary for the kids. One to a benefit auction where the band will play (Sandy volunteered to drive the trailer) on Oct 6th. The other is the District 16 marching band festival on Oct 13. Still looking for more parent drivers. A lot of the kids have signed up already.
6. We will do a Chinese auction at the Christmas concert this year and only auction off the conducting of the band. Also was suggested not having a mid-concert break and playing straight thru, then having punch/cookies afterwards.
7. Reviewed the cost of writing the drill and music. Josh is asking for \$1500 for both. Motion to accept by Rae, seconded by Dawn. Michelle requested earlier discussion of this next year.

8. Old business: Rayme said the Scrips program is just about ready to launch. Would like to do some sort of info meeting or flyers for parents. Maybe able to go live with this by next month. She will need some volunteers to help.

9. Car show income was \$668.50. we had less sponsors this year and am hoping for increased participation next year. We had approx 60 cars this year.

10. Pie day: apples are reserved from Bristol Orchard for \$12 bushel, this will add \$400 for the cost of the pies. Pt Huron Pastry shop suggested increasing pie prices to \$8 this year. Sale dates for pies will be Sep 28-Oct 16th. Set up date is Oct 23, pie day 24th. Doug had previously volunteered to pick up the apples, Sandy said she will take the trailer to pick up dough, sugar ect. Dawn will buy the food for meals and Rae will help with food also.

11. Band Camp went well. It was suggested that we could do more planning ahead of time for next year with registration, order forms, health forms ect.

12. Uniform cleaning was done, cost \$900, and took 3 weeks. It had been 3 yrs since they were dry cleaned.

13. Craft show is coming up, need a new chairperson. Kelly volunteered and Teri said she would do the bake sale again. Claire Jackson had said previously that she would volunteer in the kitchen that day.

14. New Business: Disney Trip costs are being rounded up. Cost of flying was discussed as nobody wants to drive down. The Disney trip would be in 2012.

15. Scrapbook crop will be April 16 setup and held on April 17. Lisa will help coordinate this again.
