Choir Camp will be \$35. This covers food, snacks, music, and paying people to come work with the kids throughout the week. Other costs this year in choir are as follows:

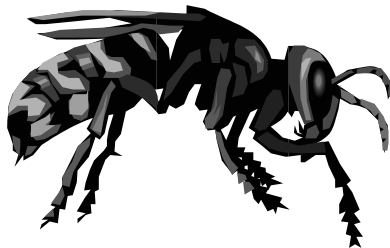
