End of day change needs to be made prior to 10:30 this year. This will assist in a safe and orderly dismissal.

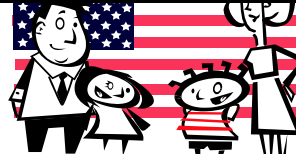
Bus Information: Students are not allowed to change buses, this is to prevent overcrowding. Parents must sign your child out at the office if you take them off of .
