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Dear Families and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2022-2023 educational progress for the Memphis Elementary School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2022-23 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school has a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given. **Memphis Elementary was not identified with any of those labels.**

Memphis Elementary School is working tirelessly to meet the needs of all learners through differentiated instruction, while simultaneously providing rigorous and challenging academic content. Memphis Elementary uses Bookworms ELA Curriculum and has fully implemented Math Expressions in every classroom as a means to provide quality instruction that will ultimately accelerate student achievement and help close subgroups' achievement gaps. Daily students participate in WIN (What I Need) Time where they are provided intervention or enrichment programming based on their needs. Based on district data, key goals for Memphis Elementary School are to continue to increase the percentage of students who are proficient and increase the student growth percentage. We also are continuing to analyze and improve our MTSS process.

As outlined by the Memphis Elementary School Improvement Plan, the key initiatives are as follows: Staff will participate in professional learning around the Literacy Essentials, Bookworms Curriculum, The Science of Reading, and educational best practices. Memphis staff will identify tiered and target instruction in all content areas to close achievement gaps and increase student growth and proficiency percentages. Memphis Elementary will also continue implementing a What I Need (WIN) Target Intervention/Enrichment Time. Memphis Elementary staff will utilize Professional Learning Communities to effectively respond to data, reflecting the needs of our students and affecting our teaching practices. Staff will use formative and summative assessments to gauge the success/failure rate of curriculum changes and as a means of strategizing and focusing instruction.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

- Process for assigning pupils:
 - Resident pupils within the Memphis boundaries are assigned to Memphis Elementary School. External School of Choice students are also accepted at Memphis Elementary, according to seat availability. - School Improvement Plan Status:
 - In compliance with State of Michigan mandates, Memphis Elementary School has developed a School Improvement Plan that is revised, evaluated, and implemented annually. Our school's goals focus on reading, writing, math, science, social studies, and intervention.
